

Children's Sports Programme - New Horizon 3-10 August 2019



Background

New Horizon is a seven day Christian festival that takes place every year at the Ulster University, Coleraine, on the picturesque north coast of Northern Ireland. It exists to provide a space and time in which thousands of people of all ages can be taught from the Bible, be inspired through worship and story, develop a missional heart, and engage with relevant and challenging issues.

The Salt Factory Sports team is responsible for leading a sports and activities programme for 8-10 year olds each evening from Monday to Friday. Team members will build relationships with the children, play lots of sports and games, teach Bible truths and demonstrate God's love through their words and actions.

Team Details

Our team will consist of up to 12 people age 17+.

Activities will be held in the main Sports Hall of the University. There will be opportunity for team members to attend the morning teaching sessions in the main tent and some of the seminars at the festival. Afternoon team meetings will consist of devotions, prayer and preparation for the evening activities.

Team members will be expected to attend New Horizon Child Protection Training at the start of the event on Saturday 3 August and the volunteer commissioning service on Sunday 4 August.

Accommodation

The team will be based in student flats on the University Campus. Each flat has a fully equipped kitchen and single rooms all of which have en-suite facilities.

Meals

Three meals per day will be provided. Team members will be expected to help with washing up and generally keeping the accommodation tidy.

Supervision

A Salt Factory Sports leader will remain with the team throughout the week.

Transport

Team members will fly overnight from USA to Dublin on 2 August and will arrive in Dublin early on 3 August. We will collect them at the airport and drive them to Coleraine. We will return team members to Dublin airport the morning of 10 August.

Passport and Visa Requirements

Your passport should be valid for a minimum of 6 months from the date of entry into Ireland and should have at least 2 blank pages. You do not need a visa.

Cost

£725 GBP to cover all in-country costs including airport transfers in Ireland, internal transport, food, accommodation, entry to the festival, Salt Factory Sports logoed clothing and some sightseeing.

Cost does not include international flights, nor travel to or from the USA departure airport.

Payment Schedule

- £350 due by 30 March 2019
- £375 due by 15 June 2019

Training

The team will receive training, cultural awareness understanding and have time to plan and prepare before the festival begins.

Debrief

Debriefing is important for reflecting on and processing what you have experienced. We will try arrange a get together for the team around 6 weeks after you return home.

Health

You will need to ensure you have comprehensive health and travel insurance cover.
