



MEDICINE AND HEALTHCARE

Jesus often met people's physical needs before he met their spiritual needs. TEAM places doctors, nurses, dentists and other healthcare workers around the world. But more than simply meeting physical needs, our medical missionaries support discipleship and church planting efforts wherever they serve.

Our healthcare endeavors go beyond treatment. TEAM's work aids underserved populations through community health outreach, counseling, training national workers in preventive care, and HIV/AIDS education. We serve in partnership with local hospitals and medical facilities, focusing on providing medical services that are not readily available within existing structures.

TEAM's medical missionaries and partners serve in diverse regions that include South Asia, the Middle East, Central America and Southern Africa.

QUICK FACTS:

More people pass through the world's hospitals each day than the world's churches.

Service opportunities exist for doctors, nurses, dentists, technicians, midwives and others in hospitals, clinics, and informal settings.

Most opportunities require a degree in medicine or related fields of study; formal or informal training plus experience is also acceptable for some opportunities.

The purpose of TEAM is to help churches send missionaries to establish reproducing churches among the nations to the glory of God. TEAM missionaries establish churches by seeking to make followers of Jesus Christ who learn and obey all that he has commanded. In certain contexts, the best means of discipleship entails the use of holistic ministry such as medicine and healthcare.

As TEAM considers the role of medicine and healthcare in ministry, we follow a set of guidelines focused on our purpose and vision:

- Medical and healthcare endeavors take place where we see a confluence of spiritual and demographic factors that indicate that God is leading us to serve in this capacity.
- TEAM leadership prayerfully considers how medical and healthcare endeavors fulfill the objective of making disciples.
- Medical and healthcare endeavors are carried out in partnership with local individuals, churches or groups whenever possible and will not be in direct competition with local medical facilities or hospitals. However, we recognize that we may have the opportunity to engage in medical ministries that cannot be done through the locally available care.
- Churches and ministries, started through TEAM's medical and healthcare efforts, work toward the reconciliation of all things to God through Jesus.
