TEAM workers in Africa and Asia are dedicated to serving indigenous groups with lives that exemplify Christ, building relationships and establishing mature churches.

QUICK FACTS:

Indigenous and tribal peoples constitute about 5 percent of the world's population, yet account for about 15 percent of the world's poor.

Service opportunities include working with women and children at risk, teaching, healthcare and more.

The purpose of TEAM is to help churches send missionaries to establish reproducing churches among the nations to the glory of God. TEAM missionaries establish churches by seeking to make followers of Jesus Christ who learn and obey all that he has commanded. In certain contexts, the best means of discipleship entails the use of a variety of ministries among indigenous and tribal populations.

As TEAM considers ministry among indigenous and tribal populations, we follow a set of guidelines focused on our purpose and vision:

- Endeavors among indigenous and tribal populations take place where we see a confluence of spiritual and demographic factors that indicate that God is leading us to serve in this capacity.
- TEAM leadership prayerfully considers how endeavors among indigenous and tribal populations fulfill the objective of making disciples.
- Endeavors among indigenous and tribal populations are carried out in partnership with local individuals, churches or groups.
- Churches and ministries, started through TEAM's efforts among indigenous and tribal populations, work toward the reconciliation of all things to God through Jesus.
