THANK YOU FOR JOINING US IN PRAYING FOR THE NATIONS!

There are more slaves in the world today than there were during the American Civil War. *Eighty percent are women — half are children*.

Some slaves are trafficked for manual labor, but most are forced into underground sex work.

We believe God's people must break cycles that keep the vulnerable oppressed. So, we invite you to pray with us this April for human trafficking victims:

- **Sun: PRAY** that victims of human trafficking will not blame themselves for their situations.
- **Mon: PRAY** that former victims will be able to find meaningful employment that doesn't put them in harm's way.
- **Tue: PRAY** that more people will realize the value God places on the lives of the marginalized and vulnerable.
- **Wed: PRAY** that God's people will not be afraid to reach out to the exploited and abused with love and kindness.
- **Thu: ASK GOD** for governmental change so policymakers will act in the interest of human trafficking victims instead of their own economic gain.
- **Fri: PRAY** for more translators to help with anti-trafficking work. Most victims are from various foreign countries and don't speak their host country's language.
- **Sat: PRAY** that organizations dedicated to fighting human trafficking will receive the support and resources they need.

Pray also for protection of the whole household.

- I. PAPUA | Some Gospel booklets have recently been translated into the Hatam language, and thanks to your support are now being distributed. The Hatam tribal group consists of 17,000 people spread over a remote, mountainous area of Papua. Praise God for making this possible!

They are covering subjects like the use of leisure time and how the Bible was transmitted to us. Many of the group members live alone or are alone in their faith within their families, so it is a vital time of encouragement. - 3. **GUATEMALA** | The Lord has provided enough donations for a portable ultrasound machine that Amie Bockstahler can take into rural villages and conduct prenatal ultrasounds with. This will help screen for any problems before delivery. Praise God!
