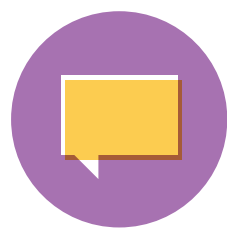
AGE OF YOUNGEST STUDENT (IN A PRESCHOOL IN SWEDEN)
