WHERE DOES TEAM OFFER OPPORTUNITIES FOR MUSLIM MINISTRY?

Over the past few years, the influx of Muslim refugees in North American and European countries has skyrocketed. We want to meet that opportunity head on. That's why we've started several Muslim immigrant and refugee ministries in non-Islamic nations, such as Germany and the United States.

Similarly, TEAM has a long history of working among Muslims in their home countries. Through medical ministries, correspondence schools and more, we've developed creative and effective ways of reaching people in places that are historically Gospel-resistant.

WILL I BE SAFE IF I DECIDE TO SERVE IN A MUSLIM-MAJORITY COUNTRY?

TEAM takes precautions to keep our missionaries as secure as possible, no matter where they are serving. We even have special training sessions for our missionaries who want to serve in places where governments are especially closed to the Gospel. Our goal is to make sure you feel prepared for every possible situation. We also have emergency systems in place should you ever need them.

WHAT KIND OF TRAINING OR SKILLS ARE NEEDED FOR MUSLIM MINISTRY?

The specific training you'll need depends on where and how you want to serve. But TEAM encourages all missionaries to enroll in a language before they depart and continue their language studies for at least two years while on the field. If you're interested in working in Muslim ministry abroad, we also recommend that you start by getting to know Muslims in your own community right now.
