- Encourage, train, and empower current volunteer mobilizing networks to creatively expand TEAM's mobilization reach
 - This could include participating in the Mobilization Campus Program
 - Assist in drip campaigns with writing, providing ideas, feedback
- Meet with peers and supervisor in regular meetings for prayer, collaboration, reporting, planning, and administrative matters
